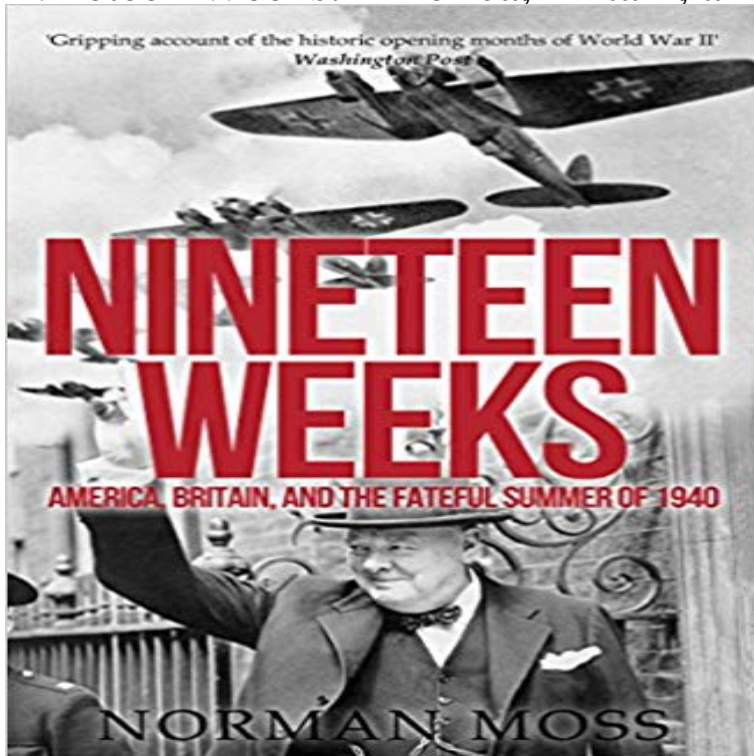


Nineteen Weeks: America, Britain, and the Fateful Summer of 1940
